25TH NATIONAL CIVILIAN BRAVERY AWARDS 2019

Invitation to apply for awards

COLOMBO, SRI LANKA, Friday, July 20, 2018—The Foundation for Civilian Bravery is now accepting applications from Civilians of Sri Lanka seeking to nominate candidates for the Foundation's awards, as listed below in terms of Foundation for Civilian Bravery Act No 4 of 2009. To be conferred at the Foundation's National Ceremony in Colombo in June 2019, the awards are for actions effected during the 2018 calendar year. On receipt of the applications, a panel of judges will select the awardees on the basis of interviews and supporting documentation. The awards and their criteria follow.

- 1. National Civilian Bravery Awards:** Those eligible for recognition are citizens of Sri Lanka who courageously - without concern for danger to life or limb - volunteer to save others whose lives are imperiled by tide, fire, mine, and rough seas and similar dangers occasioned by natural or manmade disasters. The awards consist of the Budal-Na Gold Award and Silver Medals for Civilian Bravery.
- 2. Civilian Bravery Biophilic Award:** Voluntary extraordinary actions to preserve and promote natural environment including bio-resources and bio-systems.
- 3. Students Civilian Bravery Social Activity Award - Gold & Silver Swan:** The award will be presented to a student who courageously and dedicatedly performs his duties to achieve the objectives of an organization for social service acknowledged by the school system.

General Requirements

1. Closing date for nominations: 28 February 2017
2. Applicable period: 1 January 2017 to 31 December 2018
3. Applications are available from the Foundation on request and may be submitted personally by the candidate or anyone who is acquainted with actions or work of the nominee.
4. In cases where the activity falls within the course of normal duty, only those who have acted beyond the call of duty will be considered.
5. The responsibility for providing evidence lies with the applicant and the candidate.
6. Students should submit their applications through the principal of the school.
7. Budal-Na Gold awardees are not eligible for additional consideration. The decision of the judges shall be final.
