1. Effective Date

This Scheme of Recruitment shall come into force with effect from the date of approval from Hon. Governor of Northern Province.

2. Definition

- 2.1 The term 'Scheme of Recruitment 'shall mean the Scheme of Recruitment for the post of Aquaculture Development Officer under Management Assistant Non Technical Segment II category of service (MN1-2016) in the Ministry in - charge of the Subject of fisheries - Northern Province.
- 2.2 The term 'Commission' shall mean the Provincial Public Service Commission of the Northern Province.
- 2.3 The term 'Appointing Authority' shall mean the respective authority to whom powers had been delegated by the Hon. Governor of Northern Province in terms of delegation of powers.
- 2.4 The term 'Service' shall mean the Service in the post of Aquaculture Development Officer.
- 2.5 The term 'Secretary' shall mean the Secretary to the Ministry to which the subject of fisheries is assigned in Northern Province.
- 2.6 The term "Period of Satisfactory Service" means the period during which a public officer has earned all the salary increments due to him by efficient and diligent discharge of his/her duties, and by passing over the Efficiency bar due to him on the prescribed dates and by fulfilling the qualifications required for the confirmation and has not committed any punishable offences.
- 2.7 The term "Active Service" means a period of service during which an officer has actually engaged herself/himself in duties and receiving salaries pertaining to him post. All period of No- pay leave other than the Government approved maternity leave will not be counted for the purpose of the period of Active Service.

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8. Terms and conditions of this service

- 8.1. An officer appointed to Grade III of service by open competitive examination shall be subjected to a probation period of three years. If the Head of the Department is satisfied himself to the effect that the officer has passed the first efficiency bar examination and that the work, conduct and attendance of the officer are satisfactory, it shall be informed to the Appointing Authority by the end of the three years and thereafter the appointment of the officer shall be confirmed if the Appointing Authority is satisfied in this regard.
- 8.2 The officer should contribute to the widows' and 'Orphans' pensions fund or to the Widowers and 'Orphans' Pension fund as the case may be.
- The General conditions for appointment prescribed in sub section 10.6 and section 8.3 12 in Chapter - II of the Establishment Code and in the gazette notification of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka are applicable.
